

## **DIRECTIONS TO PAINT THE LOG**

If you do not have 4WD contact me to ensure you are picked up!!!! There are 6 miles of driving on dirt roads, after 2-3 miles, the road becomes quite rough and low, two wheel drive cars will likely not make it (although a Fiat made it last year!). Feel free to pullover part way and hike the rest, if you want to leave water/supplies on the side of the road I am taking multiple trips and can pick them up.

From HWY 80 EAST in Truckee:

-Take Exit **188A** toward Truckee

-Turn **Left** onto **Donner Pass Road**----- .2 Mi

-At traffic circle, continue straight, stay on Donner Pass Rd----- .2 Mi

-At traffic circle, take **3rd exit** onto **CA-89 N**----- 14.3 Mi

-**Left** onto **Bear Valley Rd/Co Route 451/ Cottonwood Rd**----- 233 Ft

-Caution, turn is after sweeping right curve on highway so be ready, also the street sign is small but the green sign at turnoff has locations like Weber Lake listed.

-**Left** onto **Forest Route 07/ Jackson Meadows Rd** -----5.5 Mi

-Kinda Tricky, photo below, dirt road eventually becomes smooth highway.

-**Left** on **Heness Pass Rd.** (pretty sure sign reads **Perazzo Meadows**)----**Pullover/Stop and Set Odometer to 0.0**

.7 Mi : Straight through the cattle guard

.9 : Straight over bridge

1.5 : Straight

1.9 : Right

2.8 : Right

2.9 : Continue Straight

3.1 : Spots to pull over and park, steep grade ahead, 2WD will probably not make it

3.5 : Steep Grade

4.7 : Make a right after blue bridge

4.8 : Stay left

5.0 : Right

5.1 : Stay Right

5.3 : Stay Right
